Quick Links

Learn how to setup a Quick Link to your depreciation rates. Quick Links behave like a bookmark or shortcut to information that is important to you, allowing you to find a specific rate within a Checkpoint.

1. Click **Research** from the black tool bar
2. Expand the **Commentary** folder from the product library
3. Locate and expand the **Australian Tax Handbook** folder
4. From the Table of Contents, locate and select **Tables and Ready Reckoners (Chapters 100-107)**
5. Scroll further to expand the **Depreciation Rates** folder
6. Click into **Effective Life Schedules** folder
7. Click content **ATO's effective life determination**
8. To create a quick link, select the **star** icon beside the content title

Note: you can setup a quick link for one or all the content within the folder

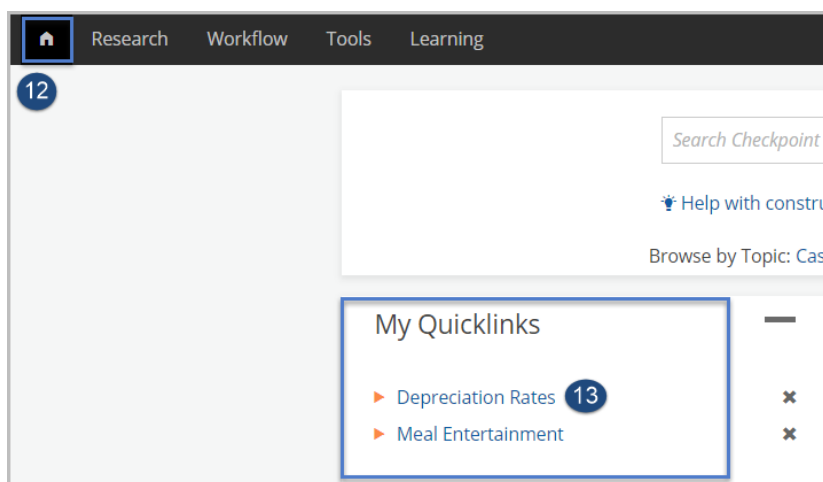

9. From the pop-up box, enter a name for the quick link
10. Select the **Save** button

11. You can access the saved Quick Link from two locations:
 - Home screen
 - Right panel of the results screen. Example will be provided below
12. Select the **Home** button from the black tool bar
13. Click the **Depreciation Rates** link from the **My Quicklinks** menu category



14. The Depreciation Rates table and contents will be displayed.
15. A search can be run within a particular content table folder or within the entire table folders
16. Enter a keyword and select the **Search** button

17. The results screen will return content for the keyword entered
18. To view results, select either the **content table title** or select the **keyword term** which appears within the document.
